I am committed to helping every student learn in my class. I believe it is important for families and schools to work together and share responsibility for student success. I understand that my role as an identified Oklahoma Better Futures Project (OKBFP) teacher is a significant responsibility and I will make it a priority when interacting with the students in my classroom. I look forward to working with the OKBFP team during the grant term October 1, 2019 and September 30, 2022 and commit to the following:

- participate in/watch a 60-90 minute online OKBFP orientation webinar;
- successfully complete an online human subject protection training (taking approximately 1-2 hours);
- complete an informed consent form for my role as a research subject;
- provide to OKBFP my school's written "opt-out" policy regarding health and human sexuality courses;
- attend an in-person 3-day Dibble Institute curriculum training;
- complete requested paperwork when applying for substitute reimbursement;
- provide student class enrollment and attendance information (numbers only, no names included);
- provide students with electronic links at specified times to administer pre-/post-curriculum surveys;
- accurately complete and submit timely monthly performance measures;
- agree to periodically be observed in the classroom to assess fidelity to the sexual risk avoidance curricula, and if necessary accept coaching to improve delivery of services;
- complete and submit an electronic Teacher Curriculum OKBFP Survey at end of the project; and
- participate actively in all requests for my assistance and response.

I am aware of my responsibilities as an identified OKBFP teacher and will make my active participation a priority when interacting with the students. I have read and fully agree to this Letter of Commitment and look forward to assisting the Social Innovation Laboratory in this role.
